
The AAALAC International Council on Accreditation has reviewed the report of the recent site visit to Shanghai BioDuro Biologics Co., Ltd., BioDuro (Beijing) Co., Ltd., Shanghai, People's Republic of China. The Council commends you and the staff for providing and maintaining an excellent program of laboratory animal care and use. Especially noteworthy were the strong administrative commitment to and support of the animal care and use program, evidenced in part by the engaged Attending Veterinarian and Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC) Chair; the generally clean, well designed and maintained facility; the overall healthy appearance of the animals; the efforts to socially house dogs; and the positive participation of staff at all levels during the site visit process. The Council is pleased to inform you that the program conforms with AAALAC International standards as set forth by the *Guide for the Care and Use of Laboratory Animals*, NRC 2011. Therefore, **FULL ACCREDITATION** shall continue.

Council acknowledges receipt of the correspondence dated July 8, 2016 detailing actions taken relative to concerns expressed by the site visitors during the exit briefing. Specifically, the items addressed satisfactorily included: providing updated sections of the Program Description; including the nonaffiliated member of the IACUC in the environmental health and safety program training; updating the dog euthanasia standard operating procedure (AC-27); scheduling the calibration of the isoflurane anesthetic machines; and addressing temperature and relative humidity in two feed storage rooms.

Council has no further recommendations to offer for improvement of the animal care and use program at this time. We look forward to following your program activities and wish you continued success.

AAALAC International requires an Annual Report detailing changes made during the year in accredited units. In the interim, AAALAC International expects to be apprised in a timely manner of significant programmatic changes or concerns should they occur. Please note that, at your request, AAALAC International will provide your institution with a separate letter simply verifying that your animal care and use program is accredited.
